EASTCONN Transition Services are free of charge for all EASTCONN adult education students and graduates, helping them move successfully into college, training programs, or employment.

Participants are encouraged to take at least one industry-contextualized course that will enhance their academic skills and introduce them to local, in-demand careers.

Students meet individually with Transitions Coaches for help with:

- Exploring careers
- Researching college and job training programs
- Scheduling college tours
- Completing applications for colleges, scholarships, and financial aid
- Searching jobs, résumé writing, and interview preparation
