Nondiscrimination in the Instructional Program

This EASTCONN school system pledges to avoid discriminatory actions and seeks to foster good human and educational relations, which will help to attain:

- 1. equal right and opportunities for students and staff members in the school community.
- 2. equal opportunity for all students to participate in the total school program of the schools.
- 3. continual study and development of curricula toward improving human relations and understanding and appreciating cultural differences.
- 4. training opportunities for improving staff ability and responsiveness to educational and social needs.
- 5. opportunities in educational programs that are broadly available to all students.
- 6. an appropriate learning environment for students which includes (1) adequate instructional books, supplies, materials, equipment, staffing, facilities and technology, (2) equitable allocation of resources among EASTCONN schools and (3) a safe school setting.

Each student, at the time s/he becomes eligible for participation, will be advised of his/her right to an equal opportunity to participate in school programs without discrimination of any kind.
